Emergency Department

Ask the Cardiologist on the phone:

- ☐ Who calls out the cath lab (cardiologist / ED staff) circle one
- ☐ Do you want heparin or lovenox?

Before Going to the Cath Lab:

- ☐ Informed Consent on chart
- ☐ Pt's weight: _____
- ☐ Interventional Cardiologist on call: _____
- ☐ Time Contacted: _____
- ☐ Pt's primary care provider: _____
- ☐ Cath lab called out: by ED staff / by cardiologist (circle one)
- ☐ Monitor: telemetry, pulse oximetry, blood pressure cuff, **pacer pads**
- ☐ 2 peripheral IV's
- ☐ Labs ordered (CBC, BMP, CPK/Troponin)
- ☐ Supplemental Oxygen to keep Po2 above 92%
- ☐ Aspirin 324mg PO
- ☐ Document if Aspirin given by EMS or at home PTA
- ☐ **EKG on the chart with the patient**
- ☐ Groin prepped bilaterally

How to "call out the Cath lab":

- HUC calls the operator and alerts the house supervisor
 - Operator has call sheet and calls in the on-call cath lab personnel

STEMI CRITERIA

MALE > 40	2mm elevation V2-V3 or 1 mm in all other leads
MALE < 40	2.5 mm elevation V2-V3 or 1 mm in all other leads
FEMALE	1.5 mm elevation in V2-V3 or 1 mm elevation in all other leads

ANTERIOLATERAL	I, aVL, V3-V6
