# **Before Going to the Cath Lab:**

Informed Consent on chart

Supplemental Oxygen to keep Po2 above 92%	
Aspirin 324mg PO	
Document if Aspirin given by EMS or at home PTA	
EKG on the chart with the patient	
Groin prepped bilaterally	

### How to "call out the Cath lab":

- HUC calls the operator and alerts the house supervisor
  - Operator has call sheet and calls in the on-call cath lab personnel

### **STEMI CRITERIA**

MALE > 40	2mm elevation V2-V3 or 1 mm in all other leads
MALE < 40	2.5 mm elevation V2-V3 or 1 mm in all other leads
FEMALE	1.5 mm elevation in V2-V3 or 1 mm elevation in all other leads
